



On December 6<sup>th</sup> 2011 **Father Nikolay Senkin** died in a tragic car accident. He is survived by his matushka and five sons. Four of them go to high school and one is studying at a special technical school. Their youngest son was born in 2000 with a facial birth defect. The family of Father Nikolay is in tremendous need of financial help.

On November 17<sup>th</sup> 2012 **Father Michael Muchachev** reposed, following a five-year battle with brain cancer. He is survived by Matushka Elena and their two daughters (born in 2003 and 2005).



On March 5<sup>th</sup> 2013 **Father Andrey Eremeyev** died of pneumonia. The family of Father Andrey is in dire need of any kind of help. Matushka Olga is handicapped and requires assistance in order to move about the house.

# Priests Have Died

The Benevolent Fund was established in 2010 by Priest Daniel Sysoev's wife, Yulia Sysoev, to aid the needy families and widows of clergy. Unfortunately, there are many financially disadvantaged clergy families in Russia, but the greatest financial need is felt by the widows of priests who have fallen victim to murder or tragedy, and we Christians have a duty to care for them.

In recent times we have seen a rise in sudden deaths among our intercessors before God—those who pray for us more often than others, through whom the Lord forgives our sins, from whom we receive comfort. At present the fund has learned of and established contact with 45 such families, and is constantly searching for clergy families in need so as to provide them with uncompensated aid.

We call upon Orthodox Christians to contribute their two mites to support the work of the Fund. On August 11<sup>th</sup> 2010 at the age of 29 the servant of God **Father Andrey Kashkov**, rector of St. Sergius of Radonezh Orthodox Church in the village of Stodolishche, departed this life. He had been the rector of that church for over 8 years, since 2002. Father Andrey was greatly respected by his parishioners for

his kindness and true witness to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. He is survived by Matushka Natasha and their four little children.

On June 29<sup>th</sup> 2007 **Father Konstantin Voz-zhennikov** (assistant priest at Sts. Faith, Hope, Love, and Sophia Orthodox Church, Viatka diocese) died of cancer. He is survived by his matushka and their two daughters, Maria and Anastasia. Anastasia is very sick with cerebral palsy. The source of their very small income is the state child welfare program.



On April 27<sup>th</sup> 2013 **Father Alexey Tretiakov** (rector of Sts. Peter and Paul Russian Orthodox Church in Uzhur, Krasnoyarsk Region diocese) departed to the Lord. He had been diagnosed with brain cancer. He is survived by

Matushka Zoya and their four children (their eldest child was born in 1999).

On the night of July 1<sup>st</sup> 2005, while his wife was in the hospital with their newborn daughter, **Father Vladimir Ivusov** was murdered. According to the police report he was killed during an armed robbery at their home. Father Vladimir is survived by his matushka and their three children.



On April 5<sup>th</sup> 2006 **Father Alexander Ziuzia** (rector of Nativity of Christ Orthodox Church in Lipetsk) died in a tragic car accident. He is survived by Matushka Elena and their three children—Veronica, Nikolay and Ekaterina. Veronica lives and studies in St. Petersburg. Nikolay and Ekaterina are still in school.



On September 28<sup>th</sup> 2000 **Father Michael Maslenikov** (assistant priest at Dormition of the Mother of God Russian Orthodox Church in the village of Kochubeyevskoe, Stavropol region) died in a tragic car accident. He is survived by his matushka and their three children—Semyon, Dionysy and Elizaveta.

On December 30<sup>th</sup> 2001, after a lengthy terminal illness, **Father Alexander Maslov** reposed. He was an assistant priest at Holy Theophany Convent (Krasnoyarsk diocese). He is remembered by the parishioners as a warmhearted man who was loved by all. He is survived by Matushka Marina and their two children, who are in dire need of financial help.



On December 29<sup>th</sup> 2011 **Father Pavel Gerasimov**, rector of Tichvin Icon of the Mother of God Orthodox Church (Chekhov district of the Moscow region) died suddenly. He is survived by his matushka and their three children



(ranging in age from 2 to 7 years).

On April 22<sup>nd</sup> 2011 **Father Sergey Chistiakov** died suddenly. He is survived by Matushka Irina and their seven children. The youngest child is 3 years old. Matushka is not able to work, and they are on state welfare. The whole family is in dire straits.



† On January 11<sup>th</sup> 2003 **Father Valery Isayev**, rector of Holy Archangel Michael Orthodox Church (Lipetsk region), died in a tragic car accident. Previously he had nearly lost his eyesight due to medical malpractice. He is survived by Matushka Ioanna and their two children.



On June 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, at the age of 30, **Father Andrey Timakov** (assistant priest at Resurrection of Christ Orthodox Church in Yoshkar) departed this life. This priest's first son was born in 2010, and his second in 2012 (four months after Father's death). The family's only income is the aid the two children receive from state welfare. Their financial situation is very difficult.

On December 28<sup>th</sup> 2010 **Father Michael Geneshin**, rector of Dormition of the Mother of God Orthodox Church (village of Vnuto, Novgorod diocese), died tragically. He is survived by Matushka Angelina and their five children.



On March 25<sup>th</sup> 2011 **Father Sergey Vorona** (rector of Kazan Icon of the Mother of God Russian Orthodox Church, village of Sentsovo, Lipetsk region) died following a serious illness. He is survived by his matushka and their three little children. There is no suitable job for Matushka in their village, and no preschool for the children. The family is in dire need of financial help.



On August 11<sup>th</sup> 2012 **Father Sergey Malkov**, an assistant priest in the Nizhegorodsk diocese, died following a terminal illness. He is survived by Matushka Tatiana and their seven children. The whole family is in dire need of financial help.



In August 2010, at the age of 27, **Deacon Andrey Tsuriak** (of the Orthodox Church of the Finding of the Vladimir Icon of the Mother of God in Vladimir) was diagnosed with progressive muscular dystrophy, leaving him severely disabled. In his fa-

mily there are two little daughters. Father Andrey and Matushka Yulia are grateful for any help.

On September 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 **Father Dionysy Triasin** died of severe heart problems. He is survived by three daughters, who are living on state welfare.



On November 7<sup>th</sup> 2005 after a lengthy terminal illness **Father Alexander Shalomicky** departed to the Lord. He is survived by Matushka Tatiana and three children under the age of 18. The youngest child was born in 2003. The family is barely able to make ends meet.
